

Olvera's Boxers Information and Application

Who we are?

Thank you in your interest in one of Olvera's Boxer puppies. We have owned Boxers off and on for over 30 years. In 2016 we lost our beloved Gunner and while searching for a new Boxer we met two wonderful ladies, Tina Starr (Ivylane Boxers) and Mary Dooley (Vincenza Boxers). Meeting Tina and Mary was a blessing, Tina entrusted us with our current Boxers, RJ (our boy - bred by Mary and owned by Tina) and Piper (our girl – bred and owned by Tina). RJ and Piper soon became more than pets, they became part of our family. They are raised in our home and we provide them all the love and attention that they deserve. In 2018, under Tina's and Mary's tutelage, encouragement, and mentorship Olvera's Boxers was created.

With Tina's and Mary's encouragement we began showing our Boxers in American Kennel Club events, focusing primarily on Conformation events and they are handled exclusively by Tina. Through the AKC shows, we have met wonderful people that are willing to share their many years of knowledge with us and that have supported us in our journey.

Since our inception, we decided not to breed for quantity, we breed for quality and healthy Boxers. Health, temperament, structure, and proper Boxer behaviors are our top priorities. Owning a Boxer is not just a privilege, but it is also great responsibility. As any other pets, they depend on us for food and shelter, but in return we will have a Boxer that for many years will be a loyal and wonderful companion to us and to our families. Boxers are also happy, playful, energetic, and highly intelligent dogs.

If you have decided to move forward and seek ownership of one of our Boxers as a pet, there are few things that you need to be fully aware before proceeding with the application.

- 1. All puppies sold as pets, and they are sold on spay and neuter contracts before 12 months of age No exceptions.
- 2. Puppies will not be allowed to leave with their new owners until after 8 weeks of age.
- 3. All puppies are sold on contracts. Puppies pricing varies from litter to litter.
- 4. Ear cropping is up to the new owner and Olvera's Boxers will not be liable and/or responsible for these procedures.
- 5. A Non-Refundable deposit of \$500.00 is required to place your name on our "waiting list". This will guarantee you a puppy from our current litter. However, we will determine the "pick of the litter" according by the date that the deposit is received. The deposit will be applied toward the total price of the puppy.
- 6. Puppy registration with AKC is up to the new owner. However, the AKC registration will be a "limited registration" which means that the dog is registered with AKC, but no litters produced by the Boxer will be eligible for registration and they will not be eligible to be entered in any show competition. Our puppies will go to families that just want a quality and healthy Boxer and they do not have intention and/or interest of showing or breeding their Boxer.



- 7. Shipping We can recommend transports that we trust, or we can work with you to find the proper means of transportation to your home. All transportation will be at the new owner's expense and we will not be liable for any accidents/incidents that may happen to the puppy during such transportation.
- 8. Please be fully aware that once you own the Boxer and if you no longer be able to provide a loving home for your Boxer or you cannot take care of the Boxer, you shall notify us immediately. The Boxer MUST be returned to us no questions asked. The Boxer shall never be sold, given away to any other individual, a company, a research facility, pet shop, dog pound, rescue organizations, and/or any other group. When ownership is transferred back to Olvera's Boxers, the purchase price is forfeited and the dog's registration certificate is signed over back to Olvera's Boxers.
- 9. We reserve the right to refuse the "Sale of any Puppy" to any person for any reason.

Olvera's Boxers puppies will go to their new forever home with the following:

- 1. Declawed and tails removed.
- 2. A 72-hour short-term warranty and one-year health warranty for genetic issues will be provided from the date that they leave our home.
- 3. Puppies will go to their new home microchipped. Olvera's Boxers will pay the microchip first year registration fee and will register the microchip with the new owner's information and Olvera's Boxers will be listed as a second contact. Annual fees after the first year are to be paid by the new owner.
- 4. Puppies will be properly vaccinated, de-wormed (as needed), and vet checked before they leave our home. Puppies will leave our home with their health and vaccination records.
- 5. AKC registration paperwork (in case that the owner wishes to register them) will be mailed to Buyer within 15 days of Olvera's Boxers receiving proof spay or neuter certification.

Now that you are familiar with what is expected from a new owner, and if still wish to own one of our Boxers, please feel free to proceed to fill out the application.
